Value of WEA Select

- ▶ The WEA Select Plans include many special provisions such as:
 - ▶ WEA Claim Appeal Process
 - ▶ Child COBRA Rate
 - Surviving Dependent Coverage
 - Continued In-Network Benefits for a 90-Day Period when a provider group terminates
 - ▶ Rate Stabilization Fund (RSF)
 - and more ...

Value of WEA Select

- ▶ The large purchasing pool covering 108,000 plan participants
- ▶ Banding together has worked for both small and larger school districts over time
 - ▶ Reduces rate volatility and administrative expenses
 - > Smooths out peaks and valleys associated with unpredictable claims costs
- Leverage with insurance companies and provider groups
- Commitment by the carriers' local CEOs

- Create competition/choice within the plan


The Process


- WEA spent seven months evaluating carriers and features for their plans

UHC's High Performance Network - Key Features

UHC – Navigate Balanced

- Emphasizes coordination of care by a Primary Care Physician (PCP)
- Highest level of benefits if referred to a specialist by their PCP
- Enrollees can self-refer to a specialist within the network and pay a higher copayment
- There are no benefits for out-of-network services, except for emergency care
- Statewide, ~70-75% of PPO providers are included in this high performance network. Western Washington includes all of the same providers, except:
 - ▶ Clark County: Providence Medical Group
 - ▶ Cowlitz County: Peace Health Medical Group
 - Kitsap County: Harrison Health Partners
 - ▶ King/Pierce Counties: Franciscan Medical Group, Harborview Medical Center Physicians, Northwest Hospital Clinics, UW Physicians, Valley Medical Group, Virginia Mason Clinics

Aetna's High Performance Network – Key Features

▶ Aetna – Washington Value Network

- This high performance network was designed specifically for WEA
- Participants can self-refer to specialists and other health care providers within this network
- There are no benefits for out-of-network services, except for emergency services
- Same as the PPO network, except in Western Washington it does not include:
 - Olympia: Capital Medical Center

Highlights for 2017-18 Plan Year

- Deductible and Out-of-Pocket Maximums Align with the Plan Year
- Prenatal care covered in full (delivery and postnatal subject to the deductible and coinsurance)
- Inpatient Copayment Moved to Per Admission Basis (Plans 2, 3 and 5)
- ▶ Chiropractic Services Limited to 52 Visits Per Year (Plans 2, 3 and 5)
- Acupuncture Limited to 52 Visits Per Year (Plan 5 only)
- > Physical Therapy Combined with Outpatient Rehabilitation Services (massage, speech and occupational therapy) and Limited to 80 Visits Per Year (Plans 2 and 3)
 - No prior authorization for massage therapy!
- ▶ Wigs—Expanded Coverage to Include Chemotherapy and Radiation—AND Covered Annually
- ▶ Telemedicine offered at ZERO cost
 - Except for QHDHP per IRS regulations

- Open Enrollment (8/21 9/29)
 - 3-step decision process during open enrollment
 - 1. Pick a plan (i.e. Plan 2, 3, etc.)
 - 2. Pick a carrier Aetna or UnitedHealthcare
 - 3. Pick a network PPO or High Performance
