

Eagle Creek has the capacity for 32 classrooms, 30 classrooms within the building and two portable classrooms. We have 25 general education classrooms including four districtwide dual-language classrooms. The science classroom, library, music classroom, two computer labs and gymnasium (cafeteria) are available for student use throughout the day and complement core student instruction. School Improvement Plan

Eagle Creek's 2018-19 school improvement efforts are focused in the area of mathematics. Our goal meets ESSA targets and ensures growth for each student. Specifically,

- 58.5 % or more students will meet standard as measured by Math SBA Data.
- 100% of K-5 students will be at grade level standard or show one at least one year's typical growth on the scale score as measured by the iReady math assessment.
- Students with IEPs will meet their IEP goals and objectives in mathematics.

To meet this goal, Team Eagle Creek will engage in professional development that will improve math performance for all students, including English Language Learners. Staff will identify and teach mathematical vocabulary, implement mathematical language routines including Number Talks, and work to increase mathematical mindsets for students. Staff will also continue learning around ACEs, Trauma Informed Practices, and Love and Logic to support the needs of the whole child.
