### **Haller Middle School students to build mock Mars colony on June 18**

ARLINGTON- Haller Middle School students will be building a life-size, mock Mars colony on Tuesday, June 18 for the third year in a row.

- What:** Mars Colonization project
- Who:** All Haller Middle School sixth graders, selected seventh and eighth grade students. One Arlington High School student.
- Where:** Haller Middle School, 600 East 1st Street, Arlington, WA
- When:** Tuesday, June 18, 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
- Details:** This will be a large scale Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) event. New stations this year include Rocketry Teams, Mars Navigation Teams and Fuel Specialist Teams.
- Visuals:** Students will be building Martian habitats including: Solar Panels, Aquaponics, Rovers, Rockets, Landers, and Robotics.
- How:** Haller received two \$1,250 Arlington Education Foundation mini-grants which were used to purchase materials for stations and a robotics station for the students. Walmart and Home Depot donated supplies for the event.
