



Student Assessment Result Comparisons



School Improvement Plan

Eagle Creek Elementary School's school improvement efforts are focused in the area of mathematics with the goal of 100% of students meeting standard or making at least one year's growth during the 2019-20 school year. Staff are engaged in professional development around the use of rich mathematical tasks as well as strategies to increase student discourse and understanding of academic vocabulary in mathematics. Eagle Creek staff area also learning and implementing strategies to meet the needs of the whole child. This includes a goal of increasing students' growth mindset and strengthening trauma informed practices and use of *Love and Logic* when working with students.
