School Improvement Plan

Stillaguamish Valley Learning Center (SVLC) is a K-8 school within Arlington Public Schools that operates under the Alternative Learning Experience (ALE) guidelines. SVLC creates individualized learning plans for all students in grades Kindergarten through eighth grade.

At Stillaguamish Valley Learning Center, our focus this year is to ensure 100% of our students show growth trending towards grade-level proficiency in both Math and Reading standards, as well as increased student accountability for Home Learning. To support this goal each student is assigned a learning plan consultant. The consultant will review student learning plans each month. When needed, an intervention is created by the consultant with input from the student and parents to support learning both at home and on campus.
