Arlington Public Schools adds additional meal distribution sites to feed kids

ARLINGTON- Starting on Monday, April 6, Arlington Public Schools is adding additional meal distribution sites throughout the district so all kids have access to meals. The district has been providing meals for all students since March 16 at Presidents Elementary and Arlington High School. The district added an additional 10 sites on March 23 in areas closer to neighborhoods where students live, and will add four more locations starting on April 6.

"We have been evaluating the expanded meal locations over the past two weeks," said Brian Lewis, Executive Director of Operations. "We have been focusing on the locations that are more distant from the city of Arlington. The four additional sites that we're adding are located within the city limits of Arlington but are not within walking distance of any of our other locations. During this difficult time, we want to make it as easy as possible for families to feed their children."

Breakfast and lunch meals can be picked up at the locations below between 9:45 a.m. and 11:45 a.m. Meals at Presidents Elementary and Arlington High School can be picked up between 10:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m.


