Eagle Creek has the capacity for 32 classrooms, 30 classrooms within the building and two portable classrooms. We have 25 general education classrooms including four districtwide dual-language classrooms. The science classroom, library, music classroom, two computer labs and gymnasium (cafeteria) are available for student use throughout the day and complement core student instruction. School Improvement Plan

For the 2020-21 School Year, Eagle Creek Elementary School's school improvement efforts will be focused on professional development in the areas of Self-Care, Relationships, Core 4, and Dynamic Instruction to support the successful implementation of Distance Learning 2.0 and the Hybrid A/B Model for the Eagle Creek community. These focus areas are
