Arlington Public Schools hosts voluntary vaccination clinics for 12 to 17 year olds

ARLINGTON- Arlington Public Schools (APS) is hosting voluntary COVID-19 vaccination clinics administered by the Walgreens Company. Vaccinations are available for 12-17 year olds and their family members if they are 12 years of age or older. The Pfizer vaccine will be offered and requires two doses.

First dose clinics will be held at the following locations, days and times:

Arlington High School (18821 Crown Ridge Blvd., Arlington, WA)

- Saturday, June 19
 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.
- Saturday, June 26
 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Haller Middle School (600 East 1st Street, Arlington, WA)

- Saturday, June 19 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.
- Saturday, June 261 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Second dose clinics will also be hosted at Arlington High School and Haller Middle School. Appointments for second dose clinics are at least 21 days following the first dose and will be scheduled at the time of first dose administration. It is recommended that parents/guardians be present for the immunization but it is not required. Parents/guardians must complete and sign a Vaccine Administration Record (VAR) or digital pre-immunization assessment and send with child/dependent if not attending.
