








# **Facility Use**

Eagle Creek has the capacity for 33 classrooms, 31 classrooms within the building and two portable classrooms. We have 31 general education classrooms and two classrooms dedicated to students in special education programs. The science classroom has been converted to a general education classroom and the computer lab has been converted to a classroom for special education support. Small group instruction occurs in the common hallways areas. The library, music classroom, gymnasium, and stage are utilized for specialist instruction throughout the day. The gym is also utilized as the cafeteria during the lunch period. A 2020 Capital Levy funded the installation of a secured entryway at Eagle Creek and new flooring throughout the school. You are invited to become an active part of our school.

## **School Improvement Plan**

For the 2022-23 School Year, Eagle Creek Elementary School's school improvement efforts will engage staff in meaningful professional development and action steps to increase collective efficacy in tier one instruction by:

- Embracing the Universal Design for Learning (UDL) principles of variability and firm goals-flexible means.
- Continuing to implement the PurposeFull People (Social-Emotional-Academic Learning (SEAL) Curriculum)

In addition, staff will engage in learning around reading instruction, specifically understanding the Science of Reading through a book study on the text Shifting the Balance by Burkus and Yates. Student success will be measured by Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR) and Smarter Balanced Assessment data.
