

Facility Use

Haller Middle School opened in September 2006. The school was constructed on the site where Arlington High School was located from the 1930s to 2002. In order to build Haller, many of the former high school buildings were demolished. Exceptions to this were the gym and music buildings that were remodeled and incorporated into the new school. The new portion of the school was connected to the remodeled gym and includes a commons, administrative offices and a two-story classroom wing. Haller's campus includes a courtyard area, baseball/softball fields, soccer/football field with grandstands, lights and a track. You are invited to become an active part of our school.

School Improvement Plan

We have made sufficient progress in each of our goals at this point in the year. The staff has engaged with UDL training with the support of Kari Henderson-Burke and other district office staff. As of the mid year point, staff will have participated in 4 module trainings.

Character Strong has been impactful for our students. We have covered a variety of topics and lessons with our students centered around character traits and development.

At this point, our behavior reflections and suspension have increased over the past few years. There are many contributing factors to this escalation in discipline, and it will be a focus of our staff during the 2nd semester.
