SnoPUD/Clean Building Act

Brian Lewis, Executive Director of Operations, shared efforts that are being made by the district regarding HB 1257 Clean Buildings for Washington. This new statewide building energy performance standard impacts all commercial buildings 50,000 square feet and larger. Brian has been working with the Clean Buildings Accelerator Program. The Accelerator Program helps us:

- Understand the law and how it applies to you
- Get assistance with compliance requirements
- Join a network of peers in a cohort learning model
- Receive tailored coaching, scanning and prioritizing of energy-saving opportunities based on site specifics and organizational interests

The district is in the early stages of this program which will help us to determine and comply with energy use.

Universal Design for Learning (UDL)

What is UDL?

An approach to teaching and learning that...

- Assumes learning barriers are in the curriculum and environment, not the student
- Seeks to remove barriers before instruction begins
- Emphasizes access to learning through flexible lesson design

Learner variability can be addressed by engagement, representation, and action and expression.
