# **CTE Update**

- Our students are mostly interested in culinary arts, 400 kids!
- Seeing a complete lack of planning and desire to look to the future, COVID exacerbated this
- About 10 percent are high flyers, know what they want to do
- Fear of failure is paralyzing many students
- Problem across the board, not happening just in Arlington
- Students are failing to launch their lives and their careers
- CTE Pathway sheets- Manufacturing pathway (about 20 pathways total)
- Handed out to 8<sup>th</sup> graders that are entering high school
- Try to make it as real as possible
- Career fairs, bring in guest speakers
- A lot of kids don't know what they want to do
- Keep all doors open, it's okay to change your mind!
- Mentoring is a good idea but it's hard to manage this
- CTE funded entirely by number of students in CTE program
- Goal trying to leverage high school and beyond plan, begin in 7<sup>th</sup> grade to choose a
  path for graduation, explore career ahead of time



# Student Internship Update

#### Internship Program Process:

- Meet with new businesses during the summer and fall
- Internship program rolls out to students at the beginning of March
- Students complete interest survey
- Student eligibility is confirmed and interview is scheduled
- Business partner meeting to develop learning objectives
- Meet and Greet for Medical Internships
- Kick Off Event
- Internship class in May
- Internships begin when school is done and finish by Aug 31st
