PAST WESTON GRADUATES NEEDED FOR PANEL DISCUSSION FOR WESTON S.T.E.M. PROJECT

Arlington (January 20, 2016) – As part of their project-based STEM project, Weston High School students will be designing and developing a new senior project to be required by Weston students to graduate. The problem-based design challenge is to answer the question, “What will their story be? How can future seniors demonstrate their specific plan for their future?”

Weston is seeking past graduates who would like to participate in the panel to share about their own experiences after graduation; specifically, what they wish they knew or had in place prior to graduating, and what they wish they knew that would have prepared them for the future. Panel members will be asked to address what information, documents, and experiences seniors could include as part of a more individualized and relevant senior project. The goal of the challenge is to prepare graduating seniors for the types of choices they will need to make beyond high school, whether it be related to finances, career choices, job searching/training, or post-secondary education.
