Arlington Public Schools now accepting K-1 Highly Capable referrals through Oct. 31

ARLINGTON- Arlington Public Schools is accepting Highly Capable Program referrals for kindergarten and first-grade students from Oct. 3–28. Referrals for other grades will be accepted in the spring for the 2017-18 school year.

Students who are highly capable may possess, but are not limited to, the following learning characteristics:

- Capacity to learn with unusual depth of understanding, to retain what has been learned, and to transfer learning to new situations;
- Capacity and willingness to deal with increasing levels of abstraction and complexity earlier than their chronological peers;
- Creative ability to make unusual connections among ideas and concepts;
- Ability to learn quickly in their area(s) of intellectual strength; and
- Capacity for intense concentration and/or focus.
