Arlington provides bus transportation to ensure access for summer school students

ARLINGTON- Summer school is well underway and some students who may not have been able to attend due to a lack of transportation are now able to attend. While transportation has been provided for some summer programs in the past, this is the first time Arlington Public Schools has offered bus transportation to Arlington High School (AHS) for summer school students. Unlike the door-to-door service during the regular school year, a number of bus stop locations are located throughout the area where students can be picked up. In the past, students would have to find their own transportation to summer school.

“We really wanted to ensure equity and access for all students to attend summer school,” said Andrea Hundredmark, AHS Assistant Principal. “Whether a student is credit deficient and trying to earn those last credits for their diploma or an incoming student is looking for credit advancement, it’s really important for them to be here.”

In addition to providing summer school transportation for high school students, bus service is also available for students attending the K-12 English Language Learner Summer Program and elementary math camp.

Summer school runs through July 26.
