



Facility Use

Haller Middle School opened in September 2006. The school was constructed on the site where Arlington High School was located from the 1930s to 2002. In order to build Haller, many of the former high school buildings were demolished. Exceptions to this were the gymnasium and the music buildings that were remodeled and incorporated into the new school. The new portion of the school was connected to the remodeled gym and includes a commons, administrative offices and a two-story classroom wing. Haller's campus includes two tennis courts, courtyard area, baseball/softball fields, soccer/football field with grandstands, lights and a track.
