Arlington Public Schools requests community feedback on bond proposal

ARLINGTON- Arlington Public Schools is conducting a series of focused discussion groups to learn community opinions about its February 2018 bond proposal. Community members are invited to participate in the small group discussions about all aspects of the bond proposal. Sessions will be limited to six participants per group and will last approximately 90 minutes. The only requirement to participate is to be a resident of Arlington Public Schools and willing to complete a brief demographic survey from which the pool of invitees will be selected.

"This is a great opportunity for community members to voice their opinions about the bond proposal," said Brian Lewis, Executive Director of Operations. "We're looking for all ranges of opinion – from those who supported the bond, those who didn't, and those who did not vote in this election."
