Weston High School is a diverse school of choice providing innovative learning opportunities that prepares students for college, career and life.




Weston High School staff addresses the whole child through numerous approaches including Trauma-Informed Practices, Restorative Practices, Staff/Student intentional relationship building, mental health and substance abuse wrap-around services, weekly whole-school Meetings, Intervention/Remediation/Enrichment period, Guest Career Speakers, and Monthly Awards/Rewards for attendance and academics.

Our focus this year is on ensuring 100% of our students show growth in their Mathematical Proficiency, Reading Proficiency, and Daily Attendance.
