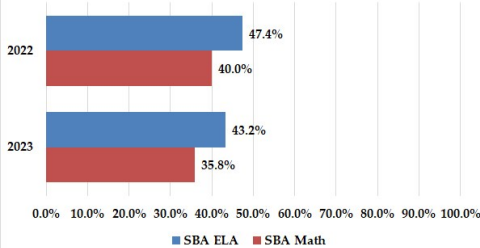

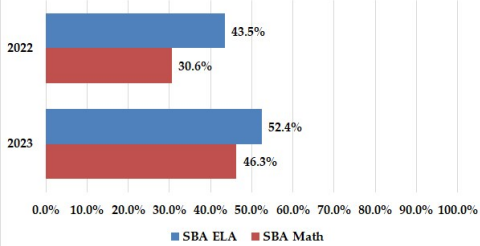
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## Student Assessment Result Comparisons

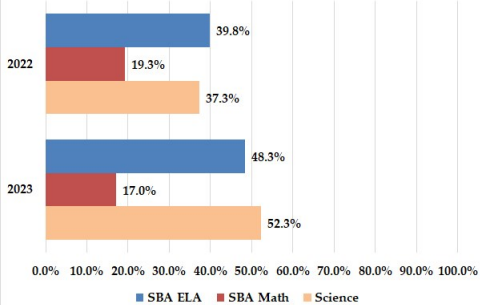
3RD GRADE STATE ASSESSMENTS

## Facility Use

Pioneer Elementary opened for the 2002-03 school year. This two-story elementary school houses 31 classrooms for use as kindergarten through fifth-grade classes, music, art, technology, special education and remedial programs for both math and reading. The facility also includes a multi-purpose room with a stage for use as a gymnasium, lunchroom and for assemblies and events. A 2020 Capital Levy funded the installation of a secured entryway at Pioneer. You are invited to become an active part of our school.

## School Improvement Plan

During the 2023-24 school year, Pioneer Elementary has been dedicated to increase collective efficacy in tier one instruction by embracing the UDL principles of variability and firm goals with flexible means. This has been done through:

- the work of PLC's- Following PLC cycles that are data driven and collaborative
- the use of MTSS-Using a Multiple Tier System of Support that addresses the needs of the whole child.
- focus on math instruction-Providing rich mathematical teaching that allows all students to succeed.

Student success will be measured by Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR) and Smarter Balanced Assessment data.
